PhD Position focusing on International Economics / Sustainability – Paris / Madrid

ESCP Business School invites applications for a PhD fellow position in Management with a focus on international trade and environmental regulation starting in September 2024. The PhD candidate receives a full scholarship for 4 years (up to €24,500/year), including a tuition waiver.

The PhD candidate will work on a project that analyzes how climate policy regulation transforms global value chains by shifting emission-intensive production between countries. The project has a strong quantitative focus, so that prior experience and motivation to learn quantitative methods are greatly encouraged.

- Close supervision by two professors, Vanessa Strauss-Kahn, Professor of Economics (Paris) and Ivan Savin, Professor of Quantitative Analytics (Madrid).
- A well-structured PhD programme.
- A strong international working environment.
- Regular joint research seminars.
- You will be part of a large research community that includes 6 European campuses.
- You will spend first two years at the campus in Paris, while the latter two at the Madrid campus.

To qualify you should have:

- Completed or are about to complete a degree in economics (ideally with a focus on international trade, environmental economics, or quantitative methods) with outstanding performance.
- Strong motivation to pursue scientific career.
- Good knowledge of statistical methods and software (e.g., R, Python).
- Very good English skills.
- Excellent communication skills, commitment, initiative.
